

ORDINANCE #14

LOUD AND DISTURBING NOISE

1. The creation or production of any unreasonably loud and disturbing noise of such character, intensity and duration in Perquimans County between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. from the activities hereinafter described so as to be detrimental to the health, safety or welfare of any person in Perquimans County is prohibited.

2. The following acts are declared to be unreasonably loud and disturbing in violation of this ordinance:

(a) The playing of any radio, phonograph, musical instrument or apparatus producing musical sounds in such manner or with such volume as to unreasonably annoy or disturb the quiet, comfort or repose of any person in any dwelling or other type of residence.

(b) The use of any automobile, motorcycle or other motor vehicle in such a manner as to create loud noise for an unreasonable period of time.

3. If any person shall violate this ordinance, he or she shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than \$50.00 or imprisoned for not more than 30 days, as provided in N.C.G.S. 14-4.

4. This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 1992 at 11:59 p.m.
