2009 4-H SUMMER VENTURES WORKSHOPS

JUNE 11-12, 2009 - FISHY FACTS DAY CAMP - Come learn how to do fish I.D., go fishing with a pole, learn about electro-fishing, do a fish print and just get all around FISHY. Youth participating in the camp will be entered in a drawing for a free lifetime fishing license. 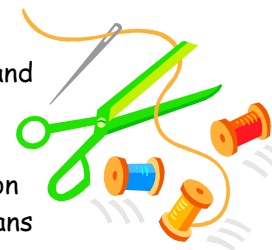


JUNE 30-JULY 2, 2009 - GREEN THUMB MINI CAMP - Grow a green thumb and more at this exciting mini-camp. Topics include soil, insects, trees, flowers and edibles. 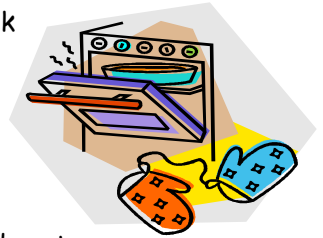

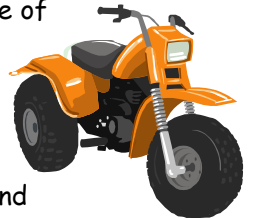
JULY 27-30, 2009 - ATV-ALL TERRAIN VEHICLE TRAINING & CERTIFICATION -

In this four day class, youth will learn: to safely operate and ride ATV's, the importance of being a well trained rider, to wear safety gear, to operate/ride at appropriate speeds and to avoid risks. The first two days will cover the in-class workbook to prepare the youth for the certification on their ATV on the last two days of the course. (For youth ages 8-12, parents must attend with their child on rider certification day.)

Time: 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. **Cost:** \$10.00. Class is limited to 10 youth. Bring bag lunch and

**ATV-ALL TERRAIN VEHECILE TRAINING & CERTIFICATION
FACT SHEET**

Youth 8-12 years old- must have a parent with them during the riding instruction.

Youth 13-16 years old- parent attendance is optional during the riding instruction.

Youth 16 and up - No supervision by adults during riding instruction.

In order to participate in the riding part of the course, youth must have and wear the following.

A helmet for ATV's

Goggles

Over the Ankle Boots

Gloves

Long sleeve shirts and Pants

Close toed shoes or boots

Youth must bring their own ATV to ride during the rider certification. The limits for the ATV's is measured in CC's . Your child's ATV must be of the correct CC designation for your child's age.

6-11 year olds under 70cc

12-15 year olds 70cc - 90cc

16 and up ride 90cc and up.
