Grant Application for County Zoning Ordinance Update

This is to request approval from the Board of County Commissioners to apply for funding from the NC Division of Coastal Management Local Planning and Management Grant Program for Fiscal Year 2016-2017. The deadline for filing the County's Application Form is Friday, April 1, 2016 therefore, time is of the essence in obtaining the BCC's approval to apply for the funding. The County's budgeting of the project (which requests Grant Funds in the amount of \$15,000 with a Local Cash Match of \$20,500 and a Local Non-Cash Match of \$2,000), may be accomplished during the regular upcoming budgeting cycle for Fiscal Year 2016-2017. Please see three attachments, as follows:

- 1) Draft Resolution for approval on March 21st by the Board of County Commissioners;
- 2) Proposed Grant Application; and
- 3) Public Notice which ran in the Perquimans Weekly on Wednesday, March 9, 2016, to inform the public of the opportunity to speak to the BCC, in regard to the grant proposal.

The recent approval of the 2015 Joint LUP Update brings with it the need to amend the Highway Corridor Overlay Districts (see Article XVII of the County's Zoning Ordinance) and to consider several other potential text amendments as identified in the Planning & Zoning Work Program. An update of the County's Zoning Ordinance has been earmarked in the Planning & Zoning Budget Requests over the last eight years, in anticipation of the State's approval of the CAMA Plan. The Planning staff is eager to address the issues and recommends that the BCC seize this opportunity to compete for funding through the Division of Coastal Management, to help defray the costs. The project will result in the update/revision of the current Perquimans County Zoning Ordinance. The project will be a second priority project which will accomplish the following:

- Adopting/amending the zoning ordinance to secure compliance with state rules in AECs.
- Amending ordinances as necessary to carry out certified land use plans, state rules, and the Coastal Zone Management Plan.
- Enforcement of ordinances adopted to carry out certified land use plans.
- Coordination of local coastal management activities with other local government management activities.
- Base mapping (zoning map) as a management tool.

Specifically, the zoning ordinance update will address, but not be limited to, the following needs/issues:

- Review of the existing zoning ordinance.
- Extensive citizen participation.
- Full compliance with current state statutes and federal regulations.
- Compliance with the CAMA certified land use plan and all CAMA regulations.
- Review consistency of the zoning map with the AECs.
- Public Sewage Disposal Systems as defined by Subdivision Regulations, individual septic systems and "appropriate certification," to support rezoning requests as per Section 1301(a)(3) of Zoning Ordinance.
- Accessory structures (requested for vacant lots).
- Accessory dwellings.
- Bona fide farms (apply State exemption to smaller farmettes).
- Campers outside of campgrounds (full-time resident and home builder living in RV)
- Camping cabins in campgrounds for part-time "vacation" shelter (no indoor plumbing, but use of nearby comfort station with toilets and showers).
- Addition of site considerations and operational considerations for existing conditional uses and uses permitted by right.
- Development limitations on multiple adjacent nonconforming lots of record in single ownership.
- Fencing requirements for retention ponds.
