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PERQUIMANS COUNTY WATER DEPARTMENT

Perquimans County is soliciting informal bids for the relocation of their Winfall Water Treatment Plant waste effluent discharge.

The project includes the installation of approximately 775 LF of water main that will allow Perquimans County to change the usage of an existing 6-inch raw water main to a backwash effluent water main. The repurposed main will discharge backwash effluent directly into Mill Creek, approximately 660 LF east of the intersection of Wiggins Rd and Cotton Gin Rd. This scope includes the installation of approximately 698 LF of 6-inch ductile iron water main by open cut, and approximately 77 LF of 6-inch ductile iron water main by jack and bore. The project also includes the establishment of a small rip-rap outfall ditch, the removal of two existing well connections from the existing raw water main, adding a new air release valve assembly, connecting the existing backwash holding tank to the repurposed 6-inch water main, repairing the site/pavement, implementing erosion and sediment control measures, and establishing traffic control measures.

The project budget is under \$500,000 so we are conducting an informal bidding process.

The bidding period will close at 2pm on February 3rd, 2026. Bids can be delivered any time during the bidding period in the following ways:
