

NOTICE OF ELECTION
Perquimans County, NORTH CAROLINA

The municipal election for the Town of Hertford and the Town of Winfall will be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2023.

Voters will be asked to show photo ID when they vote. All voters will be allowed to vote with or without ID. Voters who lack ID can get one for free from their county board of elections. Find out more at ncsbe.gov/voter-id.

Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.

Absentee ballots will be mailed to voters who have requested them beginning October 6, 2023. A voter can fill out an absentee ballot request at votebymail.ncsbe.gov, or by filling out a request form provided by the board of elections. The request must be received through the website or by the Perquimans County Board of Elections by 5 p.m. October 31, 2023.

Registered voters who live within the boundaries of The Town of Hertford or The Town of Winfall may vote in the municipal election. Municipal contests include the Mayor and (2) Town Commissioner seats.

The voter registration deadline for this election is 5 p.m. Friday, October 13, 2023. Eligible individuals who are not registered by that deadline may register and vote at any one stop early voting site during the early voting period. New registrants will be required to provide documentation of their residence.
